***Please note that we welcome all dogs, however we have a limit of one dog per room if weighing over 20kg. Two small dogs are permitted if the total weights is under 40kg.**

***Please note that we do not accept dogs as specified in regulations made under the Control of Dogs Act 1986 "Restricted dog breeds or strains and crosses of them"**

For the consideration of other guests, pets are permitted in the hotel restaurants and bar only at the restaurant manager's discretion (this may be restricted to quitter times in consideration of other guests).

Your pet may join you for dinning in the Garden Bar Area, The Haggard (when open) and any outdoor areas allocated for food or drink service only.

Pets are not allowed in The Barton Rooms (Bar or Restaurant), The Elizabethan Rooms, Castle Keep Or Banquet Hall while food or drinks are being served or taken.

You may have to make arrangements for service of breakfast in consideration of these restrictions but our team will be more than happy to help.

N.B. Reservations which include your pet staying with you can not be made on line. These reservations will have to be made by calling our reservation team directly. We have a limited number of pet friendly rooms and this will ensure that all is prepared for your stay. We can supply bedding for your pet, however we would recommend you bring your own to help your pet. You will have to bring your own drinking and feeding bowls.

All guide dogs/ assistance & service pets will be permitted; however, we do ask that you allow our staff advance notice so we may best accommodate your needs.

Dogs are welcome 7 days a week but you must book our dog package in advance so we can prepare for your arrival.

We reserve the right to require immediate removal of any pet that displays unacceptable behaviour or dangerous behaviour, including but not limited to, biting, excessive noise issues such as barking, aggressiveness towards people and/or other animals, and evidence of disease, or urination/defecation in public areas.

. Under no circumstances is your pet allowed to be left unattended in your guest room at any time. We can provide a contact number for a pet sitter, should you require this service. This service is strictly between you and the pet sitter.

All pets staying with us will have to produce an up-to-date vaccination card or acceptable proof such as your vets records on arrival and a copy will be retained for our records.

We request that you leash, cage, or firmly hold your pet when they are in all/any common areas of the hotel.

- We ask that you use the designated pet areas on the grounds around the property and clean up after your pet.
- The guest agrees to release, defend, and indemnify Barberstown Castle from any and all claims or damages related to your pet's stay at the hotel, including any claims by third parties.

Due to extensive cleaning after a pet stay in a room, we will charge a non-refundable cleaning fee of €50.00 per day, to your guest room account. Additional charges will be applied due to any damage. (This cleaning fee is waived for all guide dogs or service pets)

While onsite we ask that you adhere to the house rules.
